# Disability Supplement Information

Disability in this context does not include short-term disabling health conditions such as a fractured leg, influenza, or corrected physical conditions such as impaired vision managed by wearing glasses or lenses.

Hearing impairment is used to refer to a person who has an acquired mild, moderate, severe or profound hearing loss after learning to speak, communicates orally and maximises residual hearing with the assistance of amplification. A person who is deaf has a severe or profound hearing loss from, at, or near birth and mainly relies upon vision to communicate, whether through lip reading, gestures, cued speech, finger spelling and/or sign language.

A physical disability affects a person's ability to perform a physical task. A person with a physical disability may be unable to perform a physical task, or may be unable to perform a physical task in a safe or efficient manner. A person with a physical disability may also be unable to perform a physical task in a safe or efficient manner.
